This enchanting gem of a finca in Es Verger was originally built in 1970 and completely renovated in 2022. It is situated in a protected area of the Sierra Tramontana, where construction licences can no longer be issued, making this a really privileged location.

A large driveway accesses the plot which has parking for several cars, and leads to an inner courtyard which forms the access area of the house. Entry is via a lovely entrance hall leading into to the living/dining area with openly-designed kitchen. From from this level there is access down to the master bedroom with bathroom en suite and spectacular views, and up to the next level of the living room with a terrace providing beautiful panoramic views.

On the ground floor there are 3 bedrooms, each with bathroom on suite and access to the terrace.

The pool area is surrounded by gardens and spectacular panoramic views, and on its large terrace there is a barbecue-kitchen, a sauna and a WC.




